## MCA Grand National Show

September 4-6, 2020

Melborne, Florida

This is a great opportunity to attend an MCA show without having to travel a really long way. If you have never been, it's something you should experience at least once. Even if you just spectate. There will be just about any mustang produced. For the more dedicated enthusiast, registering to show your car can also be a fulfilling experience. Just remember that your Mustang's finish, and cleanliness, will be the most important factors in the judging process. The extent of that preparation depends on what class you are in. For Daily Driven they do not judge the engine compartment or undercarriage. For Occasional Driven they will judge the engine compartment, and the undercarriage. These are the two largest and most common classes, so competition is strong. But winners are based on final point count based on your car's independent judging. If you fall into the defined point scale you will get the appropriate award:

Occasional Driven - Total Points available is 250

Gold 242 to 250 pts. / Silver 235 to 241 pts. / Bronze 227 to 234 pts.

Daily Driven - Total Points available is 200

Gold 194 to 200pts. / Silver 188 to 193pts. / Bronze 182 to 187pts.

Specialty Class consists of Shelby, Roush, Saleen, and Boss:

Specialty - Total Points available is 250

Gold 242 to 250 pts. / Silver 235 to 241 pts. / Bronze 227 to 234 pts.

If you don't want to "show", I still recommend registering in Display Only. It's becomes a cheap parking spot on the show field. Sometimes parking for specatators is very limited. For first timers that are considering registering, and you have questions, talk to one of our members that have attended several MCA National shows. To name a few: Steve Collins; Dave Owen; Bill McDermott; Chip Bozeman (MCA Gold Car Judge); Terry Gossell. Any of us will be glad to answer your questions, and provide hints that will help.

If you are considering registering, you probably should decide pretty soon. Most national shows have limited spaces, and at a destination site such as this one they can fill up well before the deadline. The same goes for getting a hotel room reasonably close at a decent price. So don't wait too long to make up your mind.

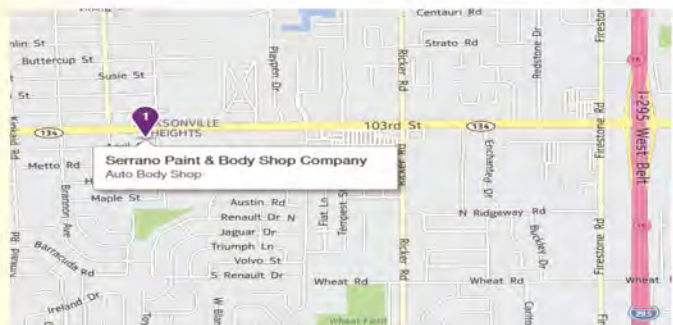
