Monthly Meeting Minutes

November 21

Dan Lombardi called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with 25 members, thanking everyone for attending the meeting. He reminded the members about:

The October minutes were sent out by Doug Hoar in the Hoof Prints email. Jon Lyon made a motion to accept the minutes and the motion was seconded by Terry Gossell seconding. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Diantha Owen presented the Treasurer's report for October. Disbursements were made to Doug Reed in the amount of \$35.01 for door prizes. There was not a winner of the Progressive drawing last month. The deposits for the period totaled \$2123.00. The ending balance as of October 17th was \$9149.41. Jon Lyon made a motion to accept the report with and Doug Hoar seconded the motion.

Craig Stambaugh provided the National Rep Report, as attached.

Past Car Show Report: Craig Stambaugh reported that besides the Hilton Head Concours de Elegance, there were several members who attended Moose Haven Car Show, and that he, Dan and Robyn Lombardi attended the Bun-nell Italian Festival. Craig also mentioned that he, Steve, and Adam attended the Dream Catchers car show.

Old Business:

JMC Host National MCA Show: Chip Bozeman, the show chair, reported we'd begin soliciting hotels in January 2025. Chip also has in individual working the Show Logo design and provided him a mock-up to create the artwork for the National Show.

John Holmgren is continuing to work on JMC Tax Exempt status and will file it 501C-7 Social Club paperwork soon. He mentioned that there would be a \$600 filing fee.

Terry Gossell announced that the JAX Children's Party will be held on December 14th instead of the 7th as previously stated. He also noted that they now have enough convertibles volunteered.

Our annual donation to the Developmental Learning Center (DLC) was also discussed. The JMC board had a meeting and recommended to the members the donation of \$3000 be donated, same as last year. Discussion ensued on the donation amount and Doug Reed recommended that any member who wanted to donate individually to DLC could do so directly through the DLC website or could even bring a check to Christmas Party to be included when the annual donation is made to the DLC representatives. Jon Lyon made a motion the JMC donate \$3000 as the board recommended, Jim Griffiths seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously.

New Business:

Doug Hoar let the members know that his brother has volunteered to modernize and update the Club website at no charge. Doug is working the update with his brother and will let the club know of upcoming improvements.

Doug Reed recommended changing the way we do our 50/50 drawing and doing away with the Progressive drawing. There was a lot of discussion, especially about the Progressive Drawing and how it came to be and the necessity to continue. Dan asked Doug to post the details of the change in the Hoof Prints so we could decide if the changes are beneficial and how it would work. Terry Gossell suggested that we table the discussion until our January meeting. All agreed.

Open Floor Discussion:

Dan mentioned the Michelin Photo Shoot opportunity that Doug Hoar sent to all members. They needed 2015-2020 Mustangs, as well as other cars. If interested they could follow the instructions sent out by Doug.

Dan announced there is no general JMC meeting in December and the next meeting is January 25, 2025.
